

Quicksteps

The Quicksteps project aims to develop effective, learner-focused, and small stepped basic education opportunities (called SLUs, Small Learning Units). In the current phase the project focuses on establishing a common base of knowledge for all partners and participants by sharing good practice on a European-wide level. Following this preparatory step, the partners intend to apply for a follow up under Erasmus+ Quicksteps also aims at creating transferable strategies to reach more people with basic education needs through Small Learning Units (SLUs). As an additional outcome, autonomy, participation, and motivation of users should be achieved and encouraged.

Different from classic and common educational settings, the quicksteps-project offers small modularized and immediately effective units of basic education which are matched to the individual needs of the learner in different contexts. The learning offers are adapted to concrete situations and based on required competences. Through the immediately perceptible benefit, the small learning units can raise the motivation to pursue further educational processes.

Small Learning Unit (SLU)

A Small Learning Unit (SLU) invites people to learn in an informal way, is easy to handle and does not require much time. A SLU is a direct way into learning, arousing curiosity by using a simple and fresh design. It works intuitively, can be used anytime and anywhere, it is flexible and spontaneously usable. Short sequences which offer quick success (satisfaction) can be a first step into further learning. A SLU is an attractive way of learning which meets the daily needs of a nowadays learner.

Categories of transferable types of small learning units (SLUs)
